
Fitting the Wall Bracket




Attach the TV

Contents may vary from photography/ Illustrations.


You will not need all these parts, so expect there to be some left over depending upon the specification of your TV.

This product is intended for indoor use only. Use of this product outdoors could lead to failure and personal injury.






You are provided with 4 diameters of TV fixing screws, M4, M5, M6 and M8. Determine the













Before fitting the wall bracket consider the shelf position. If you position the wall bracket too low, the shelf could be too close to the floor, if you position the wall bracket too high, the TV could be too close to the ceiling and/or shelving be too high. Use the dimensions below as a guide.





After completing step 5 you will have fittings left over, please keep for future reference







Attach the brackets to the back of your TV using suitable screw, reducer and spacer combinations









Ensure level before final tightening. DO NOT over tighten screws. Tighten screws by hand only 1. Hang Shelf Bracket









After you have attached your TV use the visuals below to determine if you need to position your shelf in the **High Shelf Position** or **Low Shelf Position**.





