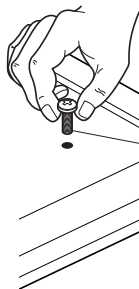
TV Screws, Reducers and Spacers



1 Measure the TV fixing holes Width and Height



! If width (X) is greater than 400mm or height (Y) greater than 400mm **STOP** installation now and contact the customer help line.



M4 = K1-K2

M6 = K3-K5

M8 = K6-K8

You are provided with 3 diameters of TV fixing screws **M4**, **M6** and **M8**. Determine the screw diameter that fits and remember for step 3.

2 Preparing the TV Mounting Plate

Use the option that fits your TV

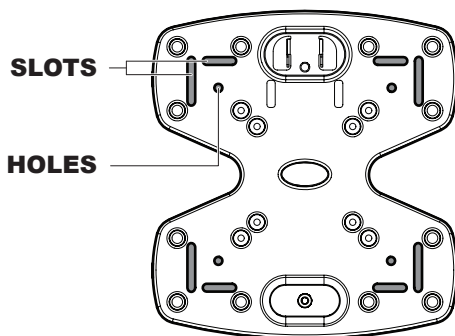
OPTION 1

- (X) 75mm x (Y) 75mm
- (X) 100mm x (Y) 100mm
- (X) 100mm x (Y) 200mm
- (X) 200mm x (Y) 100mm
- (X) 200mm x (Y) 200mm

OPTION 2

- (X) 75mm - 400mm (Y) 75mm - 400mm

When attaching adaptors **C** you must always use **HOLES x4** and either of the **SLOTS**.



Before you fully tighten the TV mounting plate check that the mounting plate holes line up with the fixing holes on the back of your TV.

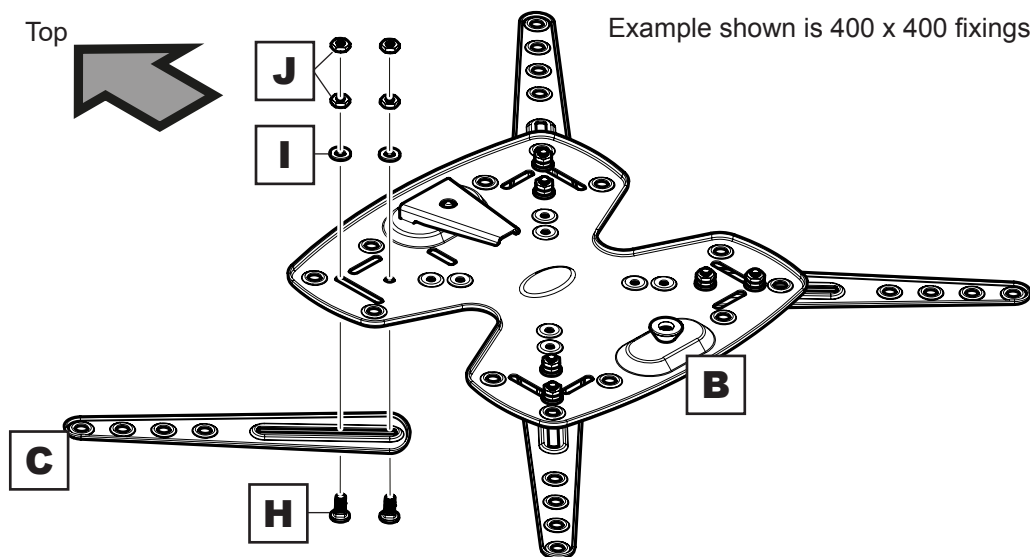
Adaptors **C** can be fixed in different positions in the slots on Plate **B** to match your TV fixing holes.



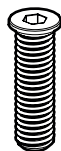
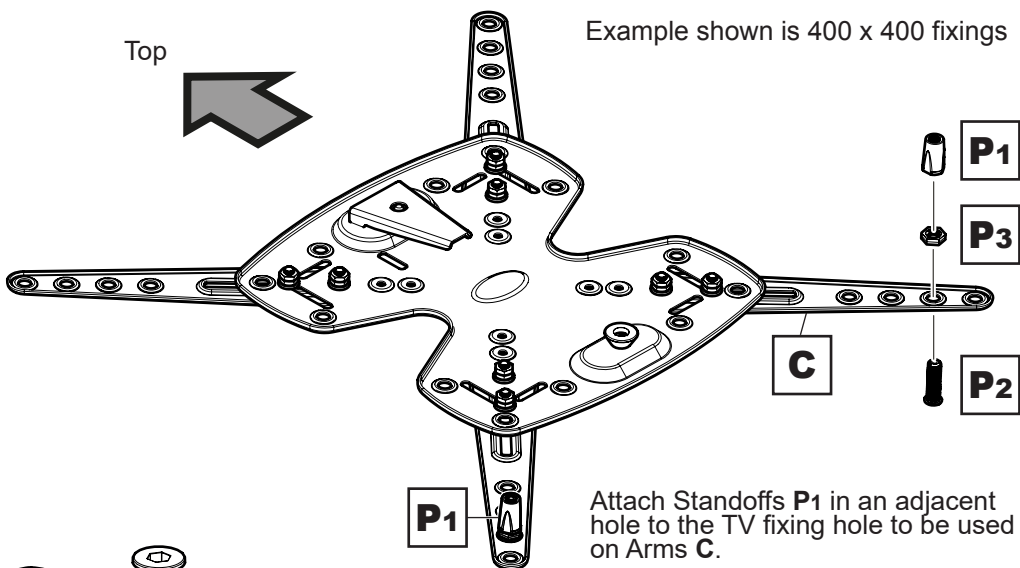

For TVs with flat / unobstructed back.

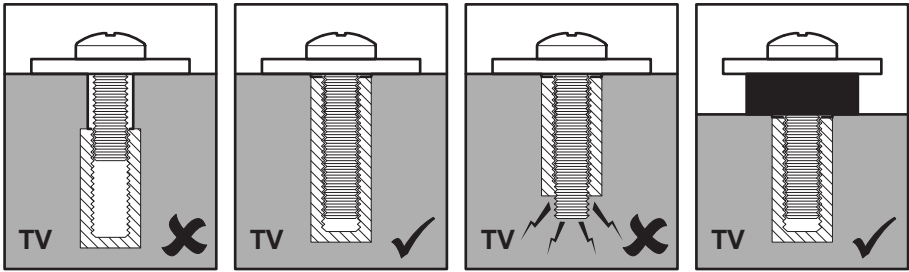

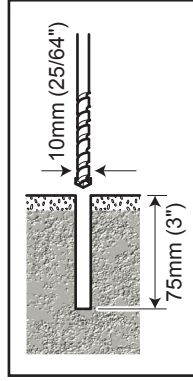
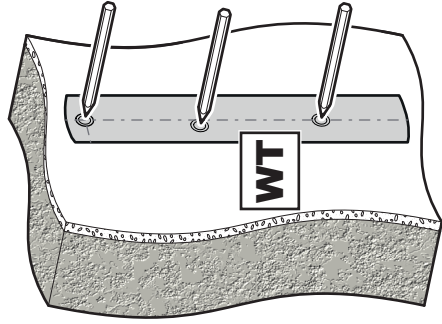
After completing step 3 you will have fittings left over, please keep for future reference.



Attach the TV Mounting Plate to the back of your TV using suitable screw, reducer and spacer combinations.

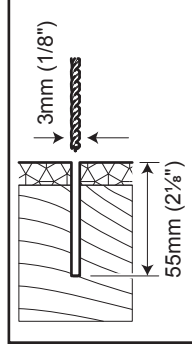
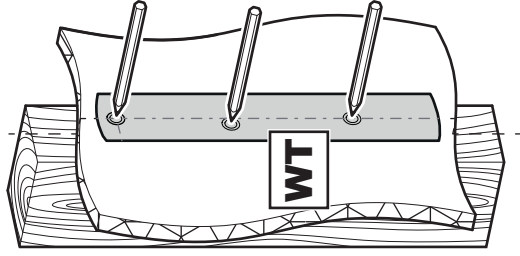

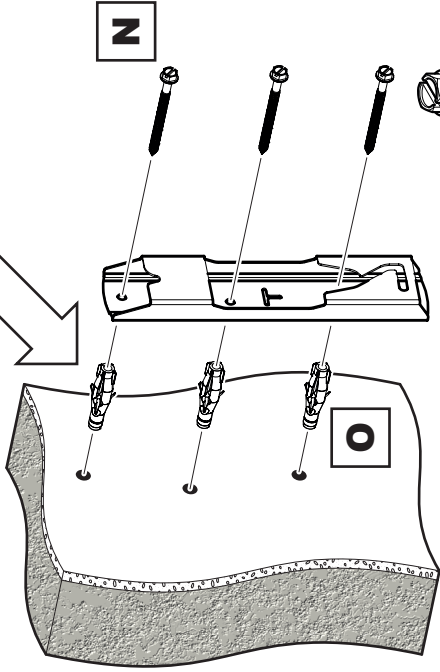
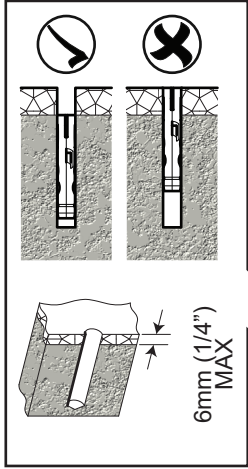


Remove Dust from Hole.

Ensure bracket is in the centre of the wood stud



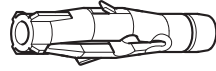

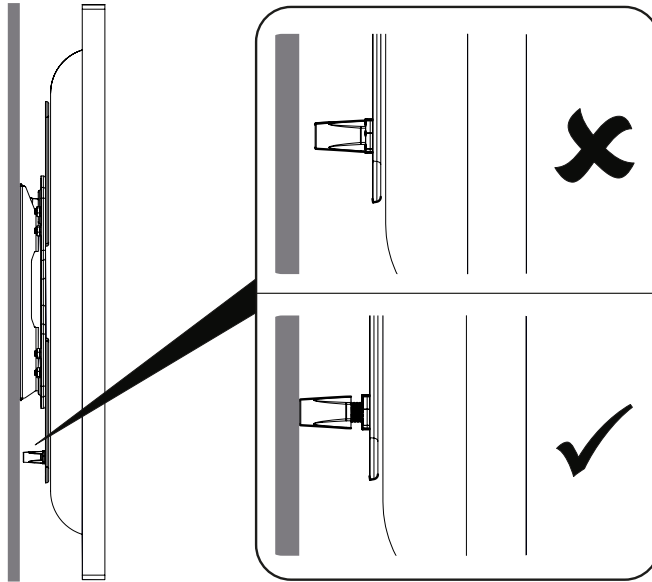
5 Hanging the TV



Hold the TV parallel to the wall. Offer the white bush towards the centre of the wall bracket and lower into position. Ensure both the white bush and locating plate securely engage with the wall bracket. When the white bush is in the horizontal slot your TV is secured.

To remove the TV, rotate TV counter clockwise as far as possible and then lift vertically.

Standoff Adjustment (optional)



When you have hung your TV, the standoffs should touch the wall. You can adjust the standoffs simply by unscrewing or tightening as required.

TV Levelling (optional)

Adjust the levelling resistance, if necessary, by tightening or loosening the screw in the white bush.



Gently adjust in small increments. DO NOT overtighten.
