





Before you fully tighten the TV mounting plate check that the mounting plate holes line up with the fixing holes on the back of your TV.






Fitting the TV Mounting Plate







Attach the TV Mounting Plate to the back of your TV using suitable screw, reducer and spacer combinations.



Hold the TV parallel to the wall. Offer the white bush towards the centre of the wall bracket and lower into position. Ensure both the white bush and locating plate securely engage with the wall bracket. When the white bush is in the horizontal slot your TV is secured.

To remove the TV, rotate TV counter clockwise as far as possible and then lift vertically.

Standoff Adjustment (optional)



When you have hung your TV, the standoffs should touch the wall. You can adjust the standoffs simply by unscrewing or tightening as required.

TV Levelling (optional)

Adjust the levelling resistance, if necessary, by tightening or loosening the screw in the white bush.



Gently adjust in small increments. DO NOT overtighten.
