Measure your VESA fixings and select TV Screws



This product fits fixing holes up to 600 x 400mm (MAX).



Determine which diameter TV Screws fit your TV and put them to one side.



We will select the correct length later.




1.2 Fitting the TV Brackets



After completing this step, you will have lots of TV screws left over. Keep them in a safe place in case you require them in future.







Attach the Backplate



Place the Backplate in the top slot on the TV Brackets. Measure from the lower mounting holes on the Backplate to the bottom of your TV.








Measure the legs, from above the feet, the same distance to find the bottom hole for fixing the backplate.



If you need some extra height to stop the bottom of the TV hitting the feet, you can place the Backplate in the bottom slot on the TV Brackets.




The legs can be attached in four different positions. Choose the setup that works best for your TV and furniture.
